### **Bikes**


This year, we have partnered with <u>Spartan Cycle Support Systems</u> to offer temporary secure bike storage in front of the venue, in addition to railings on the side road to the right of the venue – please ensure you bring your own bike lock. Please note: no bikes can be brought into the venue itself.

### Bee Network

The nearest tram stop is Media City UK, which is approximately five minutes' walk from the venue. The stop is located in zone two of the blue to Ashton-under-Lyne to Eccles line (see Metrolink map here)


