Hello and welcome!

On behalf of the GMCA Environment Team, we would like to thank you for taking the time to apply and be part of our school eco programmes.

We would like to create a community of education establishments across the region which is able to share their stories and reach out when there's a stumbling block.

We have 29 eco projects currently launching in schools and colleges this year across Greater Manchester, this is on top of the 25 schools who are now running their own Eco Refill Shop. We have found over the last 12 months that kick-starting small eco projects which benefit the wider school community has many additional benefits, including an enriched curriculum and pupils with new-found skills and real-life experience of running a small enterprise. For those schools yet to return their signed Grant Form Agreement and invoice (only a few) we are unable to release your funding until we've completed this process, and like you, we're keen to see your project commence as soon as possible.
